Prices on the specified equipment or parts are exclusive of all city, state and federal excise taxes including, without limitation, taxes on manufacture, sales, receipts, gross income, occupation, value added tax, use and similar taxes. Wherever applicable, any tax or taxes will be added to the invoice as a separate charge to be paid by the customer. Out-of-state customers receiving products or services must pay state and local taxes where applicable.

Spare Parts: Unless otherwise specified, spare parts are additional options.

Manual: A basic operation and maintenance manual will be supplied with the machine, if applicable.

Pre Installation Document: A pre installation document will be sent out for every machine placed in production. The last two pages of this document must be filled out and faxed to 330-830-4557 or emailed back to customerservice@weldmaster.com before installation and training will be set up. If you have not received a copy of this document, please call us at 330-833-6739.

Installation and Operator Training: Installation of equipment and training of operators may be necessary with the purchase of the equipment. Installation and training, when necessary, will be listed on the quotation. The customer is responsible for the removal of crates from the container, un-crating and disposal of all crating materials. If at the time installation is supposed to occur your country is listed under United States State Department Travel Warning, we may, at Miller Weldmaster's sole discretion, delay your installation until the Travel Warning for your country has been lifted. We use website: http://travel.state.gov/travel_warnings.html as our source of information. If we decide to delay your installation, we will train your technician at our facility at no additional charge. Any services performed by Miller Weldmaster which are not included in the quotation will be billed to customer at Miller Weldmaster's regular hourly rate for such service. Miller Weldmaster shall also be entitled to a full reimbursement for reasonable meals, lodging, travel, or other expenses related to the performance of such services by Miller Weldmaster not set forth in the quotation.

Electrical and Air Connections: Due to local state regulations, the connection of the electrical and air to the machine is the responsibility of the customer. If any additional electrical work needs to be done to meet city, state, country or union guidelines, Miller Weldmaster will attempt to accommodate your request. However there may be an additional charge.

Radio Frequency Interference: Due to the potential problems stray RF interference can cause equipment malfunctions, the customer is responsible for shielding the Miller Weldmaster equipment from RF interference.

Test Material: Miller Weldmaster understands the associated cost with testing material and fully intends to use as minimal of test material as possible. Limited Warranty: The equipment is covered for 12 months after date of installation against manufacturing or parts defects if any and 12 months after installation on labor; however, in order for the warranty to be valid, the customer must provide written notice or email us at service@weldmaster.com of a warranty claim to Miller Weldmaster on or before the applicable 12 month expiration date. The customer is responsible for travel costs during the warranty. The customer pays for shipping of components under warranty period. The heating elements, heater relay, thermocouple, glue tips, glue lines, needles, loppers, and cutting blades are not covered by the warranty. Remedies on Default: In consideration of Miller Weldmaster's extension of credit and agreement to receive installment payments, customer hereby grants Miller Weldmaster a purchase money security interest in the equipment purchased from Miller Weldmaster. Upon the occurrence of a default by customer, including nonpayment of any amount due, Miller Weldmaster shall have all rights and remedies of a secured party with respect to the equipment. Furthermore, customer agrees that Miller Weldmaster shall have the right to shut down the PLC Program upon default, including nonpayment. Miller Weldmaster's exercise of such rights shall be in addition to any and all other available remedies. Customer hereby waives and releases any claims that it may have against Miller Weldmaster for taking such action including, without limitation, any claims for losses, expenses, or damages incurred by Customer related to the equipment, or Customer's production, business or otherwise.

Indemnification. Customer shall indemnify, defend and hold Miller Weldmaster, its officers, employees, directors, representatives, agents, successors and assigns harmless against any and all losses, claims, damages, judgments, liabilities, or expenses, including, without limitation, reasonable attorney fees and expenses, incurred by Miller Weldmaster as a result of or arising out of (1) customer's breach of this agreement; (2) the transportation, installation by customer, improper storage, unauthorized service, positioning of equipment, use of component parts not manufactured by Miller Weldmaster, alteration or repair of the products or services sold to customer in a manner inconsistent with its design; (3) any claim by a third party against Miller Weldmaster for any errors, omissions, defects, or any and all claims regarding the manufacture and operation of the product and services sold to customer; (4) actual or alleged direct or contributory infringement of, or inducement to infringe, any United States or foreign patent, trademark, or copyright by reason of the design, manufacture, construction or use of the product or services being sold hereunder, including infringement arising from compliance with the specifications set forth in this Agreement, or for actual or alleged misuse or misappropriation of a trade secret resulting directly or indirectly from customer's action; (5) any act or omission of customer or its agents, employees, representatives or subcontractors. Customer shall promptly notify Miller Weldmaster of any suit filed against it on account of any such indemnification obligation hereunder.

Assignment: The agreement, nor any term herein may be assigned by purchaser without the express written consent of Miller Weldmaster.

Confidentiality. The customer acknowledges that it may obtain certain confidential or proprietary information of Miller Weldmaster ("Confidential Information"), including, without limitation, designs, data, ideas, drawings, specifications, trade secrets, formula, technical experience, financial data, financial information, and other valuable, confidential and proprietary information, which may be disclosed to customer or for which customer may have access. During the term of this Agreement and at all times thereafter, customer agrees not to disclose to any person, firm, or entity any Confidential Information, except to those of its employees who have a need to know and only to the extent the employee has signed an agreement of confidentiality restricting any disclosure of such Confidential Information. Customer agrees to promptly and fully disclose to Miller Weldmaster all ideas, inventions, discoveries, enhancements, improvements, creations, designs, materials, works of authorship, trademarks, and other technology and rights and any related improvements or modifications thereof, whether patentable or not, copyrightable or not, or otherwise protectable or not under any form of legal protection afforded to intellectual property (collectively "Innovations"), relating to any activities or any of the Confidential Information of Miller Weldmaster and its affiliates, conceived or developed in whole or in part by the customer, or its employees, agents, representatives, successors, or assigns, at any time prior to, on, or after the execution date of this Agreement. Any such Innovations shall be the sole property of Miller Weldmaster, and the customer shall acquire no rights whatsoever in such Innovations. The customer hereby agrees that if customer breaches this section, Miller Weldmaster shall incur irreparable injury and harm and money damages would be an insufficient remedy, and as such, Miller Weldmaster shall be entitled to seek injunctive relief restraining customer from further breach of this section. Customer agrees that Miller Weldmaster may utilize photographs, drawings, DVDs, and other such duplications of the Equipment being purchased hereunder for its marketing and other similar purposes, provided Miller Weldmaster removes any reference to the name of the Customer in its use of such information. The rights granted to Miller Weldmaster hereunder shall be without restriction or interference from Customer, and shall be deemed to be a royalty-free license of such items to Miller Weldmaster.

Force Majeure. Neither party shall be responsible for any acts or omissions of the other party, nor for events beyond its reasonable control (hereinafter referred to as "Force Majeure"), including but not limited to Acts of God, changes of laws or regulations or other acts of government, labor disputes, strikes, riots, mobs, fires, floods, wars, embargoes, travel warnings or advisories, terrorist activities, impossibility to obtain necessary material, labor, machinery, transportation, provided the party which has reason to believe that, due to the Force Majeure it will not be able to perform according to this Agreement, shall give to the other party written notice setting forth the cause and expected time of the delay or impossibility to perform.

Governing Law: This agreement and any disputes relating thereto shall be construed according to the law of the State of Ohio. Miller Weldmaster Corporation's policy is one of continual product improvement and we reserve the right to alter design and/or specifications without notice. Design, technical and pricing details of Miller Weldmaster equipment remain the sole property of Miller Weldmaster. Transfer to unauthorized users is not permitted without the written consent of Miller Weldmaster Corporation. In the event that any legal proceeding is commenced or arises out of the provisions of this Agreement after application of the arbitration described above, said legal action shall be commenced and filed in Stark County, Ohio, or the U.S. federal courts with jurisdiction over Stark County, Ohio. Customer hereby knowingly and irrevocably waives any objection on the grounds that improper jurisdiction or venue to an action in the State of Ohio, and agrees that effective service of process may be made upon customer by mail at the last known address of the customer.

Cancellation: The parties agree that if, after acceptance of order, purchaser cancels this contract and Miller Weldmaster has commenced construction of the equipment contemplated herein, an amount of the down payment may be retained by Miller Weldmaster dependent on the percentage of completion, the degree of non-ordinary design, and to reasonably compensate Miller Weldmaster for its loss from such cancellation. In the event that customer fails to pay an amount properly invoiced to customer, fails to pay any other amount due under any agreement with Miller Weldmaster, or otherwise breaches any obligation or covenant contained in this Agreement or in any other agreement with Miller Weldmaster, Miller Weldmaster may, in its discretion, in addition to other remedies to which Miller Weldmaster may be entitled without affecting an election of remedies, cancel or terminate this Agreement upon notice to customer, or suspend performance by Miller Weldmaster under this Agreement until customer pays for such charges or amounts.

Acceptance: Customer has read and understands these terms and conditions and agrees that by entering into this agreement customer has accepted any and all terms and conditions contained herein. Any additional or contradictory terms or conditions contained in the bid package, brochure, manual, pamphlet, acknowledgment, invoice, purchase order, change or other communication, oral or written, heretofore or hereafter furnished by customer is hereby objected to by Miller Weldmaster, and shall be of no force or effect. No course or dealing between customer and Miller Weldmaster, no customer usage in the trade, shall be relevant to supplement or explain any additional or inconsistent manner, any term or condition of this Agreement.

Validity: The quotation is valid for 30 days from quotation date.

Customer acknowledges that the specifications have been prepared between the customer and Miller Weldmaster, and Miller Weldmaster makes no guarantees or promises with respect to the specifications hereunder. Miller Weldmaster shall not be responsible for any damage or injury resulting to or caused by its product or services by reason of installation by customer, improper storage, unauthorized service, positioning of equipment, alteration of the product or services, use of component parts not manufactured by Miller Weldmaster, neglect or abuse or the use of the product in a manner inconsistent with its design.
